

































Port Dickson's water supply shortage causes high water consumption at the water purification station

(Seremban 20th) The Senate Minister Datuk Seri Aminuddin pointed out that there was a water supply shortage in Port Dickson last weekend. Many foreign tourists arrive, so the water consumption exceeds the budget.

He said that the heavy rains on Saturday caused the river to be very turbid, so the water company had to close the water treatment station to avoid contamination of the drinking water.

He said this at a press conference after presiding over the Senate Executive Council today. Among those present was Mr. Zhang Yuxiang, the Senate Executive Councillor.

He said that on Saturdays and Sundays, the number of tourists is very large, the water consumption is very large, and the closure of the water filter station makes it impossible to deliver the water, especially at high places, which leads to a shortage of water supply.

However, he said that the water supply has gradually returned to normal since yesterday.

He also said that the liberalization of fully vaccinated people across states and counties has caused crowds to appear in all counties in the state. In addition to tourism, there are also many wanderers returning to their hometowns, and there is frequent traffic on the road.

He was pleased to say that the number of confirmed cases of Coronary Disease in Senzhou is in the range of more than 100 to more than 200 cases. Yesterday, 114 cases were reported. Although they have returned to more than 200 cases, they are all first-and second-degree patients.

He said that 103.2% of adults who received the first dose of coronavirus vaccine in Senzhou people reached 103.2%, and 100.7% who completed the two doses of vaccines. There is only a 2% difference between the two. Those who have not been vaccinated or missed can go to a nearby health clinic. Vaccination.

He said that the vaccination rate for adolescents between the ages of 12 and 17 reached 87%, 23.6% of those who received a single dose of the vaccine, and 13% of adolescents who were not vaccinated. These students must also go for the vaccination as soon as possible.

He said that regarding the Malacca State Assembly by-election, Pakatan Harapan will go to support the election and appeal to voters in Malacca State to actively return to their hometowns to vote. Ketua Bahagian Perhubungan Awam Syarikat Air Negeri Sembilan Sdn Bhd (Sains), Norzita Ismail dalam kenyataan malam ini memaklumkan keadaan itu juga telah mengakibatkan kenaikan paras air sungai serta kualiti air mentah menurun.

Dalam perkembangan lain, Pengarah Angkatan Pertahanan Awam Malaysia (APM) Negeri Sembilan Lt Kol (PA) Mohd Syukri Md Nor berkata seramai sembilan mangsa membabitkan sebuah keluarga di Kampung Tanjung, Nilai dipindahkan ke Pusat Pemindahan Sementara (PPS) Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Dato Mohd Said, selepas kediaman mereka dinaiki air dalam kejadian banjir kilat yang berlaku petang tadi.

"PPS itu mula dibuka pada 7.30 malam tadi namun ada keluarga yang berpindah ke kediaman saudara-mara jadi jumlah yang menetap di PPS setakat ini hanya melibatkan sembilan mangsa sahaja setakat 10.30 malam ini," katanya.

Katanya, di Kampung Pedas, Rembau pula seramai lima mangsa daripada tiga keluarga terdiri empat wanita dan seorang lelaki dipindahkan ke kediaman keluarga mereka yang terdekat.

"Kesemua mereka dikeluarkan dari rumah masing-masing kira-kira 7 malam tadi," katanya.
